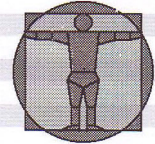



conforms with the BS EN ISO 9241, 1999: Ergonomic requirements for office work with visual display terminals (VDT's); Part 5: Workstation layout and postural requirements, which replaced the BS 7179 Part 5 in June 1999.

This summary certificate is based on evidence of satisfactorily passing the tests required by the British standards referred to in the BS EN ISO 9241, Part 5 and additional ergonomics testing and evaluation carried out by FIRA.

This range of desking is considered to be capable of meeting the minimum requirements as stated in the Annex of the European Commission's Display Screen Equipment (DSE) Directive (90/270/EEC) and the minimum requirements as stated in the Schedule of the Health and Safety Display Screen Equipment Regulations, 1992. Therefore, the above desking system is suitable for use at the DSE workstations. However, actual area of the work surface and configurations should be defined according to the needs of the user and the task. This can easily be determined by carrying out a task analysis.
